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

Andalusian roads are a cyclist's haven, winding over testing mountain passes and through remote landscapes with scarcely a car in sight. The region's cycling culture is vibrant and welcoming, with clubs and groups meeting regularly to tackle the terrain together. It's a place where friendships are forged over shared challenges and triumphs, and where the love of the sport creates an instant bond.

What truly makes an Andalusian cycling trip, however, are the physical challenges—the steep climbs, the twisting descents and the relentless sun. These are the moments that test your legs and reward your courage, transforming each ride into a personal victory and a story to be told.

"the Puerto del León challenge."

Embrace the ultimate cycling challenge at Puerto del León above Málaga—a beautiful climb that passes through Montes de Málaga Natural Park

This formidable 16km climb, with an average gradient of 5.6% and reaching an uncomfortable 11.8% at its steepest, stands as a true measure of endurance.



following the cork roads to Ronda.

Many of the roads lead towards the Parque Natural Sierra de las Nieves and Ronda. Theyare like an odyssey through time, meandering endlessly under the watchful eyes of ancient cork and chestnut trees. The roads are shaded by these trees and are a testament to solitude and serenity, with minimal traffic to disturb the peace. Surrounded by silence, cyclists are reminded of the slow rhythm of life in this corner of the world, as evidenced by the cork trees that line the path each taking 8 to 9 years to regrow its precious bark.



a mirage of vineyards and Andalusian heritage.

Against the backdrop of the mountain ranges Ronda emerges like a mirage, its vineyards and deep cultural roots painting a picture of Andalusian pride and heritage. The city, perched atop a deep gorge, is a spectacle of natural beauty and architectural marvel. Its famed bridge, an engineering wonder, spans the chasm below, offering views that have inspired artists and writers for centuries. Ride through history on the Puente Nuevo of Ronda, a marvel of architectural ingenuity that embodies the city's rich history.

The arch over the dramatic El Tajo gorge not only connects Ronda's old and new towns but also offers stunning views.
